

All quiet for Llewellyn

David Llewellyn of Bargoed improved his chances of finishing third the 1984 Castle Combe Formula Ford championship, by finishing fifth in the penultimate round on Saturday. Llewellyn had a quiet time throughout the race and takes a three point lead into the final round on October 13.
