Silverstone, Northants – Sunday July 17th 2022 Supplementary Regulations

- The Vintage Sports Car Club will organise an Interclub Permit Race Meeting at Silverstone Circuit, Northants on Sunday July 17th 2022.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising Club may issue for the event
- 3. Motorsport UK permit number ******* (Interclub) has been issued. **This event is NCAFP inscribed.**
- The meeting is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club, to members of the AMOC, BARC, BRSCC, CMMC, MGCC, CSCC, TR Register, Bentley Drivers Club, MSVR, 750 MC, and Morgan Sports Car Club. see D,4.3.1
- Rounds of the following Championships will take place

116 Trophy Championship Mighty Minis Championship

- Competitors must hold Motorsport UK racing licences of Interclub or higher grade and (if applicable) Club membership cards. Pre-event Signing-on will take place.
- 7. The Circuit is Silverstone (National), Northants and is 1.64 miles (2.64km) in length. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.
- 8. Scrutineering will take place in accordance with Motorsport UK regulations on the day.

90 minute scratch race for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.

2 x 15 minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.

 2×20 minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Championship Regulations.

2 x 15 minute scratch races for registered competitors driving cars conforming to Series Regulations.

Classes are as specified in Series Regulations. **Awards:** As per Series Regulations

2 x 20 minute scratch races for British/American cars. Regulations can be found at www.cmmotorsportclub.com

Classes are as specified for this race.

Invitation CMMC 'Classic' Challenge

2 x 20 minute scratch races for Sports cars, GTs, and saloons produced from the 1950s to 1970s. Classes will be determined upon number of entries but as a guide will be:

A: Up to 1400cc, B: 1401cc to 1600cc C: 1601cc to 2,000cc, D: 2,000cc to 3,000cc, E: Over 3,000cc F: Cars running to FIA spec G: Invitation class H: Cars conforming to AMOC Innes Ireland Series I Cars conforming to AMOC Jack Fairman Series J: Hawthorn Challenge cars

Awards: Trophy to winner overall and winners of AMOC Series. First, second and third in class subject to 3, 5 and 8 starters respectively

Invitation Pre-War sports cars/FISCAR compliant cars/ Invitation 50s sports cars

2 x 20 minute scratch races for cars complying to the above categories.

Classes will be as specified in Series Regulations or according to numbers.

Awards: As per Series Regulations or first, second and third in class subject to 3, 5 and 8 starters respectively.

Invitation CMMC 'Modern' /GT Challenge

2 x 15 minute scratch races for Sports, saloons and GT cars post 1980.

Classes will be determined upon number of entries but as a guide will be:

A: Up to 1400cc, B: 1401cc to 1600cc

C: 1601cc to 2,000cc, D: 2,000cc to 3,000cc,

E: Over 3,000cc

F: Cars complying to AMOC GT Challenge G: cars complying to AMOC Aston GT4 Challenge H: Cars complying to AMOC Intermarque

Awards: Trophy to overall winner and also winners of AMOC Series. First, second and third in class subject to 3, 5 and 8 starters respectively

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on Wednesday, June 29th 2022. Entries MAY be considered after this date but only if accompanied by an additional £30. NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER WEDNESDAY July 13th 2022. Entry fees for:

The CMMC Classic Challenge and Pre-War/FISCAR/50's is £460 (one race £285), Modern Challenge will be £420 (single race £245). WRDA cars £420

All other Race Entry Fees are via the relevant Championship/Series race organisers.

All entries <u>must</u> be made on the official form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. *To save administration time and costs, entries will be acknowledged by e-mail whenever possible. Please include your e-mail address on the entry form.*

Entry information may be e-mailed (complete with signature) to avoid delay. Entry forms may also be faxed and posted. Entry will only be accepted on receipt of the fee and properly completed form.

Cheques should be made payable to **Classic and Modern Motorsport Ltd** unless otherwise specified above. Payment can also be made by BACS as shown on the entry form or credit card.

Entries will be selected to conform with H.30 and i) Registered Championship/Series contenders first and ii) entry forms received in chronological order. In the event of over subscription a reserve list of up to 30% of the grid will be accepted on the basis of the receipt of the entry forms.

Entry fees will be refunded under the terms of H.30.1.2. Entry fees will also be returned if a competitor notifies the organiser in writing, email or by FAX by 5.00pm on Wednesday July 13th, 2022 that he wishes to withdraw his entry. There will be NO REFUNDS after this cut off date. An administration fee of £25.00 will be deducted after June 29th. - 11. The maximum number of starters in each race will be 40 (46 116 Trophy) and the minimum will be 20. The minimum number of entries in each class will be 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right either to cancel the meeting, the race or amalgamate practices, races or classes or substitute races as appropriate.
- 12. Other senior officials will be:

- 13. For each of the races a 15 or 20 min qualifying session will take place. Some practice sessions may be amalgamated. Details of these will be published in Final Instructions. Grid positions will be determined by times recorded in official practice/race finish order or as per relevant championship/series regulations.
- 14. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written.
- 15. Grid starts will be used for all races (except WRDA, 116 Trophy). The starting signal for all races will be given by lights. In the event of any starting lights failure the Starter will revert to use of the Union lack
- 16. Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after each race. Protests. Entrants are reminded that protests should be made in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations C.5.1.
- 17. Fuel supplies will be available at the circuit.
- 18. **Admission** per standard entry will be 4 Personnel passes and 2 Paddock Car Park labels (if applicable). No animals are allowed.
- 19. It is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she completes the requisite number of laps. After receiving the end of race or practice signal cars will complete a full slowing down lap and leave the Circuit as directed by the marshals.
- 20. Judges of Fact (G.10.2) will be named for: Judges, Technical, Timing, Flag infringements and track limits.
- 21. Race engines must not be run before 8.45 am or after 18.00. Competitors not complying with this may be excluded.
- 22. Transponders will be required at this meeting as per Q.12.8.1. Please make sure your number is CLEARLY written on your entry form.
- 23. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the Meeting, the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
